City Utilities of Springfield, MO, a multi-service utility delivering electricity, natural gas, and water services to more than 106,000 customers, needed a way to provide timely data about consumption and efficiency to customers across its three different service offerings. While existing technology offered visibility into gas and electricity consumption for the utility and its customers, the options for managing water usage were limited.

City Utilities selected Silver Spring Networks, a leading platform and solutions provider for smart grid and smart energy networks, to deploy a smart grid triple play: an advanced metering infrastructure (AMI) that would help the utility improve operational efficiencies across all three of its service offerings while empowering City Utilities' residential and commercial customers to make better energy and water usage decisions.

"City Utilities was looking for a single, overall solution that would allow them to manage all services," said Josh Roper, VP of product management and advanced metering for Silver Spring Networks. "They didn't want to deploy multiple networks. As they change the way they read meters and access that usage data, they didn't want to have to continue to read water meters manually."

Solution

Silver Spring Networks already offered a state-of-the-art consumer portal that

allowed utilities' customers to track and manage gas and electricity usage. To extend the functionality from gas and electric metering to water metering, Silver Spring partnered with Master Meter to create technology that would give customers the all-in-one solution they were looking for.

"We had identified Master Meter as a leading meter manufacturer, and their metering solutions impressed us from a hardware and technology perspective," said Helen Park, director of strategic alliances for Silver Spring Networks. "They had deep experience running AMI and AMR [automatic meter reading] water-only networks, and they were looking to partner with a company with a strong networking customer base, so the partnership was a natural fit."

The partnership incorporates Master Meter's proven advanced water metering products with Silver Spring's existing multi-application network, creating a comprehensive solution that allows utilities to easily track and bill their customers through a single reliable, secure network. Master Meter's products are easily retrofitted to almost any existing water meter, resulting in a simple, fast, and wireless installation process with no programming or special tools required by the installer.

For the new smart water solution, Silver Spring embedded its communication



protocol into Master Meter's Interpreter Universal AMR register, an all-digital LCD encoder register that replaces the original basic manual read register on almost any meter and allows wireless connection with water meters in the field.

The partnership connects end users in near real-time with data previously only available to utility managers, allowing customers to track usage history and accurately predict monthly expenses. Both residential and commercial customers will be able to download an app to monitor up-to-date usage and costs throughout the month instead of waiting to review their usage information after the fact.

Data from the Master Meter Interpreter register travels over Silver Spring's IPv6 capable network, a powerful smart-grid system that delivers speeds up to 1.2 Mbps while maintaining ubiquitous coverage and reliability. The network is secure from end-to-end, going beyond basic data encryption to provide

tamper protection and device and user authentication.

Result

Utilities that serve water customers in addition to electric and gas customers now have a single fully integrated solution for conveying usage information back to the consumer.

The partnership between Master Meter and Silver Spring Networks consolidates AMI infrastructure, eliminates redundant networks, and improves overall operational efficiency. And while the partnership itself is new, customers appreciate that the technology behind it is well-proven, reliable, and stable on both the register side and the network side.
